Texline unites design with technology for housing

Gerflor's Texline flooring is a Gerflor Fibre Technology (GFT) loose-lay, luxury, domestic sheet vinyl which unites decorative trends with leading technology to bring fresh solutions to house building projects where looks, performance and fast-track fitting are priorities.

Part of Gerflor's residential housing collection, Texline embodies the latest decorative trends in wood, mineral and linear designs, whilst augmenting them with realistic graining and sophisticated colours to evoke natural moods or contemporary chic in both modern and traditional settings.

However, home buyers will not only be inspired by Texline's first class designs but also by its comfort and practicality. At 3mm thick, it is luxuriously cushioned, thermally efficient and sound insulated to 16db. Plus Texline is R9 slip resistant and will take considerable wear and tear without impact on its appearance due to its 0.3mm wearlayer and stain-resistant, hygienic, easy-to-clean, PureClean™ surface finish.

Texline also benefits from Gerflor's unique construction combination of a compact interlayer and patented GFT textile backing, which enables up to 35 m² adhesive-free fitting directly over concrete with little subfloor preparation and without applying ply or screed to the floor. It also remains flat and automatically compensates for minor irregularities beneath for an improved overall finish.

In addition, Texline is waterproof from above and below and tolerant of 90% RH allowing it to be installed where new subfloors are not yet fully dry or damp conditions. It also encompasses technology that helps reduce common post-installation issues such as curling, lifting and bubbling, thereby lowering remedial work for repair.

Both house builders and homeowners can also be reassured by Texline's eco credentials: it is 100% recyclable, made using environmentally-friendly materials and processes to the highest international standards and contains 97% recycled fibres in its GFT backing system, which is made using recycled plastic bottles.

Texline has a 15 year product guarantee and comes in convenient two, three and four metre width options to minimise waste and avoid joins.
