Gerflor Scores Big with 'Taraflex' at the University of Brighton Cricket Academy with Batting and Bowling Brilliance!

When The University of Brighton required a major refurbishment on site at their indoor Cricket training grounds, they entrusted international flooring expert, Gerflor, to deliver the ideal sports floorcovering solutions for this much-needed upgrade of the facility.

Approximately 735 m² of Taraflex® Performance SL in 'Clay', was specified to meet ECB performance guidelines, selected for its outstanding durability and a striking option for cricket training. This was further complemented and enhanced with also 1502 m² of Taraflex® Evolution in 'Mint Green'. Taraflex Performance was chosen for its uniqueness as a fast-track loose lay solution, and with it being specified in this format for the project, no adhesives were required on site. This simplified the renovation process and significantly reduced installation time and cost.

The Square One Cricket Academy (User of the facilities) at the University of Brighton enables students to combine their degree studies with world-class cricket training, with 60 fully funded places available each year for both women and men. The academy is designed to support talented players through elite coaching, structured strength and conditioning, performance analysis, and competitive match play, all delivered alongside a full academic programme. By integrating sport and education, the academy helps students develop as cricketers while gaining valuable qualifications, preparing them for future pathways both within professional sport and beyond university life.

The newly completed Brighton Cricket Academy now stands as the largest indoor cricket facility in the UK and Northern Hemisphere, occupying a repurposed 2,200 sqm Virgin Active tennis centre at the University of Brighton's Falmer Campus.

This flagship facility was delivered in partnership with Square One Education and the University itself, as part of a long-term vision to create a performance hub for cricket development in the South-East. The complex includes nine high-performance cricket lanes, two tensioned training cages, specialist netting systems, and Gerflor surfacing that meets ECB guidelines throughout. Every element of the install was designed with multi-user flexibility in mind, enabling elite-level training for Sussex CCC professionals as well as regular access for schools, students, clubs, and grassroots players.

Commenting on the project, Michael Evans, Gerflor Key Account Manager for Sport and Education said, "The project came to us through Durant

Sports' interaction with the university. They chose Taraflex® Performance SL due to its consistent bounce and high-quality performance. The flooring also offers the benefit of quick and efficient replacement, meaning that when areas are overused, such as batting and bowling ends, sections can be replaced with minimal downtime and no need for subfloor repairs."

ensuring players can perform at their best while staying protected."

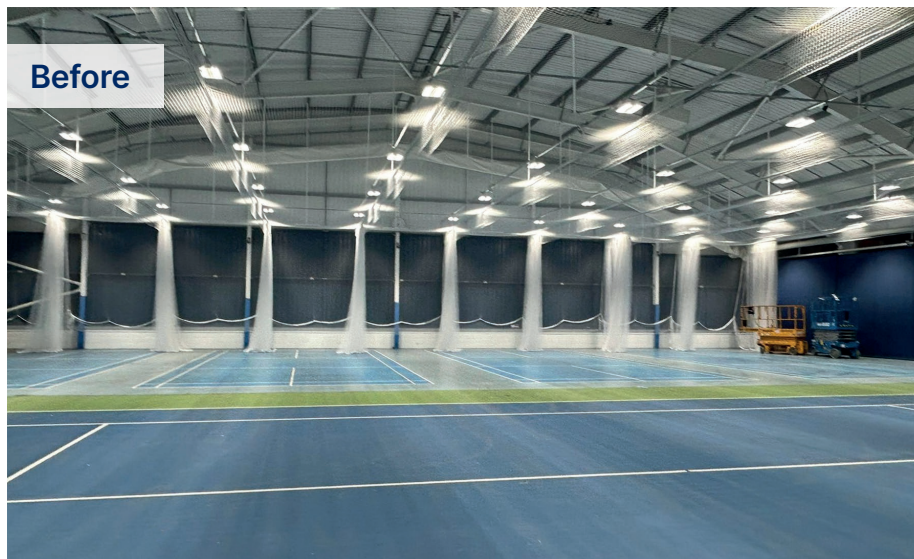
To meet the stringent criteria set by the ECB, the installation of the new Taraflex® vinyl sports flooring needed to be both innovative and delivered to an exceptionally high standard, ensuring performance, safety, and durability for elite-level cricket training.

The solution demanded precision planning, technical expertise and an in-depth understanding of the requirements of high-performance sporting environments.

Established in 2008, Durant Sports specialises in the design, manufacture, and installation of cricket facilities, including scoreboards, ground equipment, non-turf pitches, and netting systems. With every project managed by their expert in-house team, Durant Sports oversees the full process from initial planning through to final installation, ensuring quality control, programme efficiency, and a seamless handover. He is a former professional cricketer who played county cricket for Kent and Nottinghamshire, before moving into coaching and cricket education.



Following his playing career, he developed a strong reputation for progressive, player-centred coaching, with a focus on learning, decision-making and long-term development rather than short-term selection outcomes.

At Square One, Rob Ferley co-founded the programme alongside Sir Rod Aldridge and Dr James Wallis, helping to create an inclusive, high-performance cricket pathway that allows students to combine university study with elite training. He is widely recognised for challenging traditional talent pathways and for advocating an approach where potential, access and development are prioritised over early exclusion, a philosophy that sits at the heart of the Square One Cricket Academy at Brighton.

Taraflex® Performance SL was specified for this iconic project as it can withstand high impact ball bounce, support quick movement and repeated use, whilst keeping athletes safe and comfortable with all the benefits of:

- True and consistent ball bounce, which is critical for replicating match-like conditions and enabling realistic training scenarios. This consistency allows players to develop technical skills, timing and decision-making with confidence, ensuring practice translates effectively into competitive performance.



- Excellent shock absorption, helping to reduce impact stress on joints and muscles during intensive batting, bowling, and fielding drills. This enhanced protection supports player welfare, reduces fatigue during prolonged sessions, and contributes to injury prevention across frequent, high-load training schedules.
- Durable, high-performance surface, engineered to cope with sustained use, heavy footfall, and repeated ball impact without compromising performance. Its long-term resilience makes it suitable for intensive daily training environments, supporting athletes at all levels while maintaining consistent performance over time.

Facilities at the centre include nine-lane indoor cricket nets with

full 18-metre run-ups, ball tracking technology with advanced bowling machines and two indoor cricket courts. At around 2,200 square metres, the Square One Cricket Academy is larger than both Lord's Indoor Cricket Centre and the National Cricket Performance Centre at Loughborough University.

Cristian Durant also added, "Rob Ferley has achieved everything he set out to accomplish and more. The centre features coloured flooring segments to indicate different bowling lengths, various coloured Spark canvas screens for dedicated batting practice, and the latest ball-tracking technology from Arc Simulations.
